

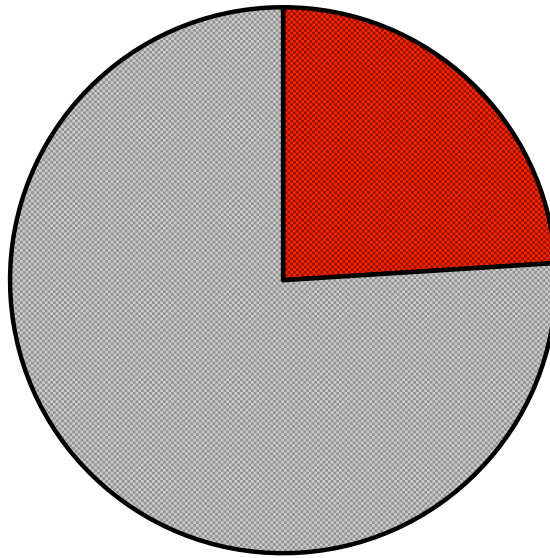

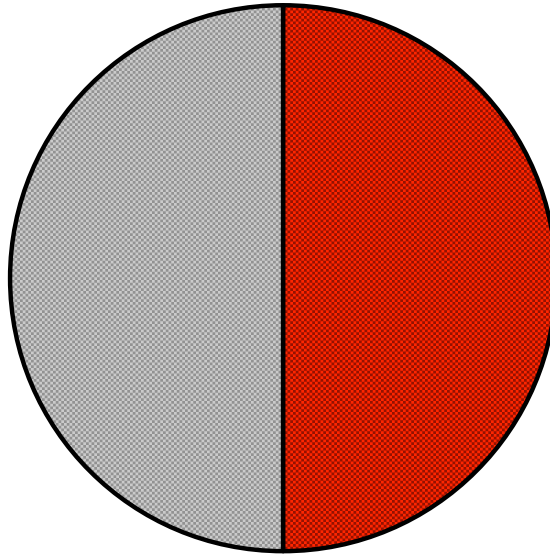
China is the world's worst polluter

China's share of global emission increase since 1990

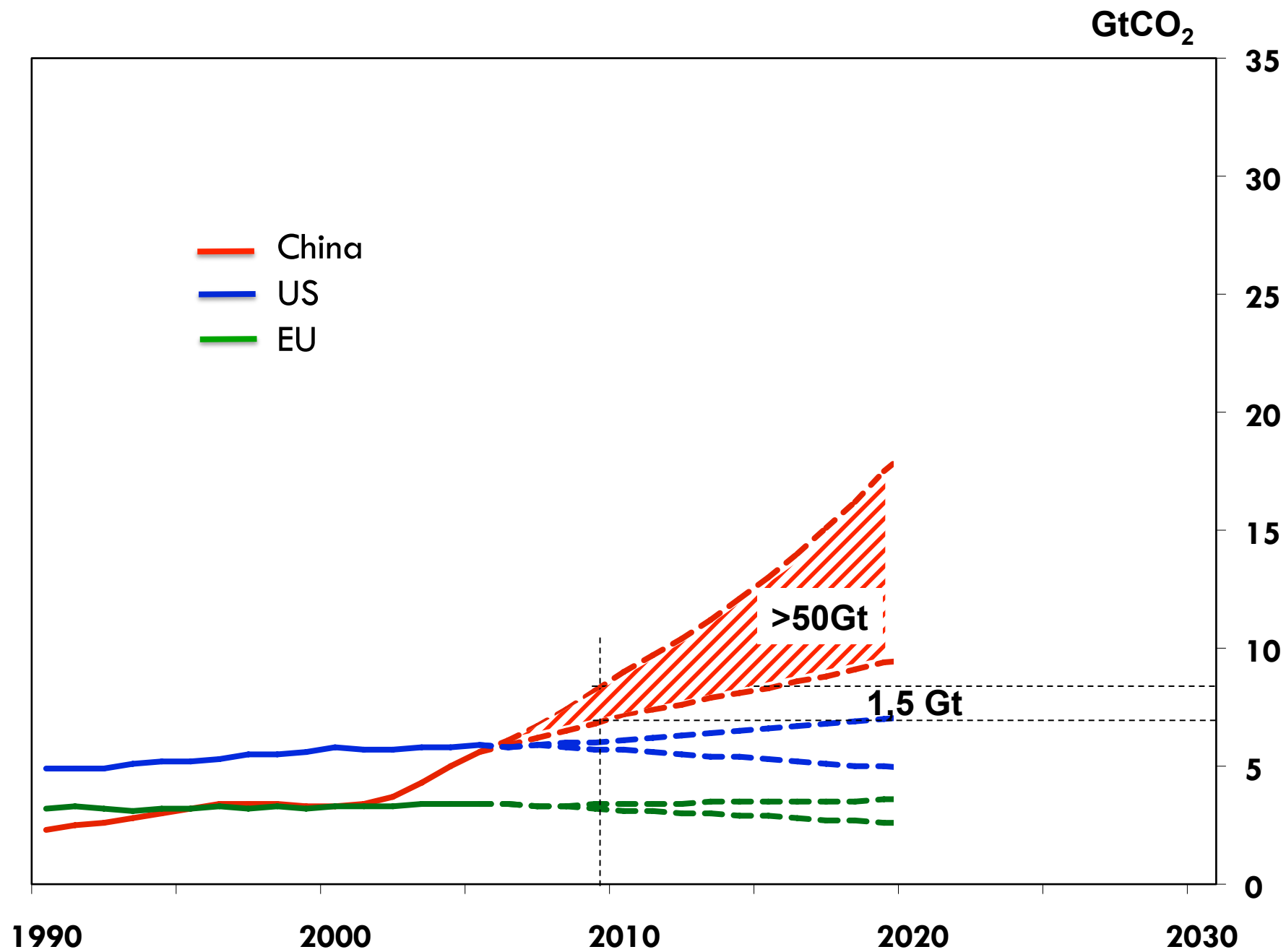


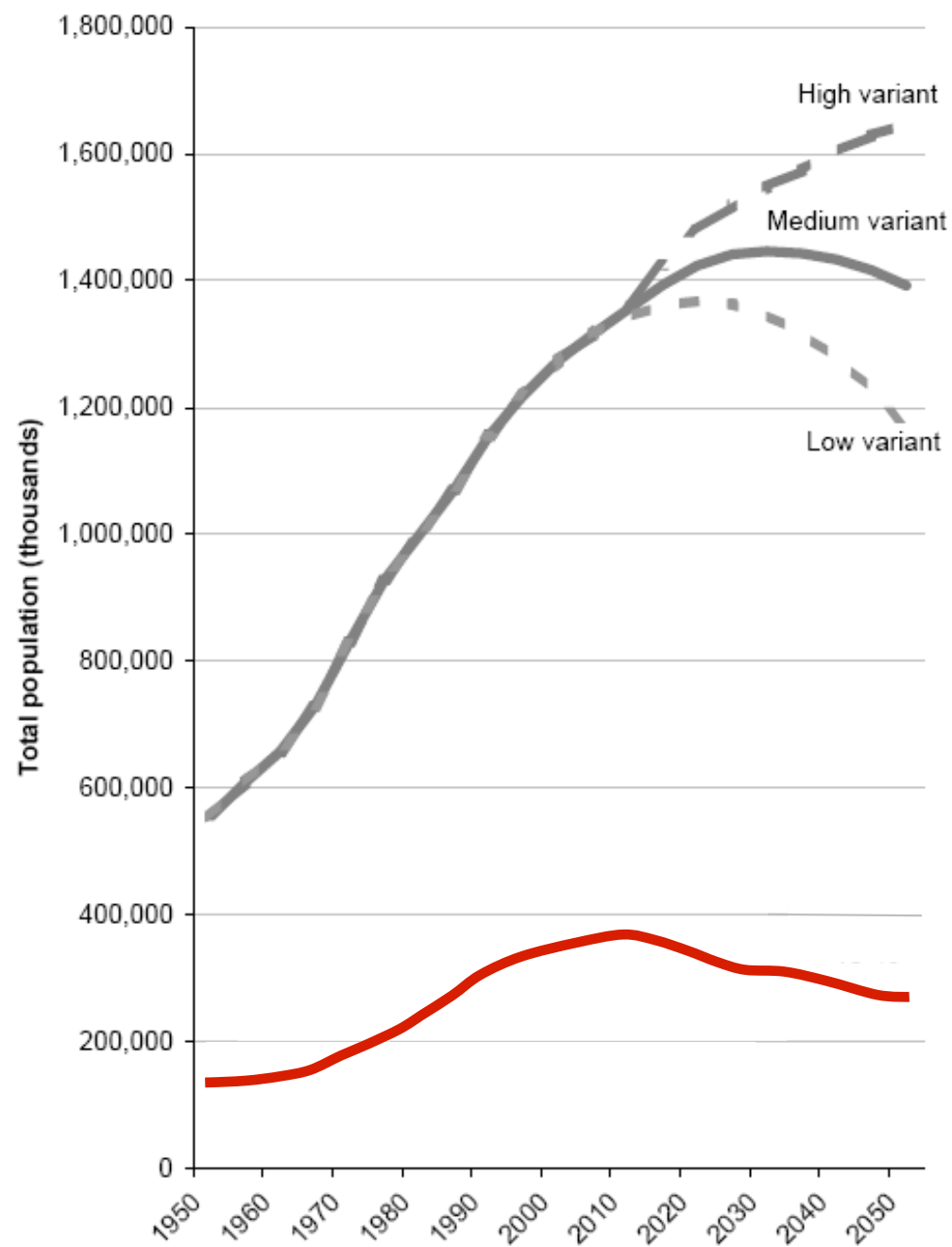

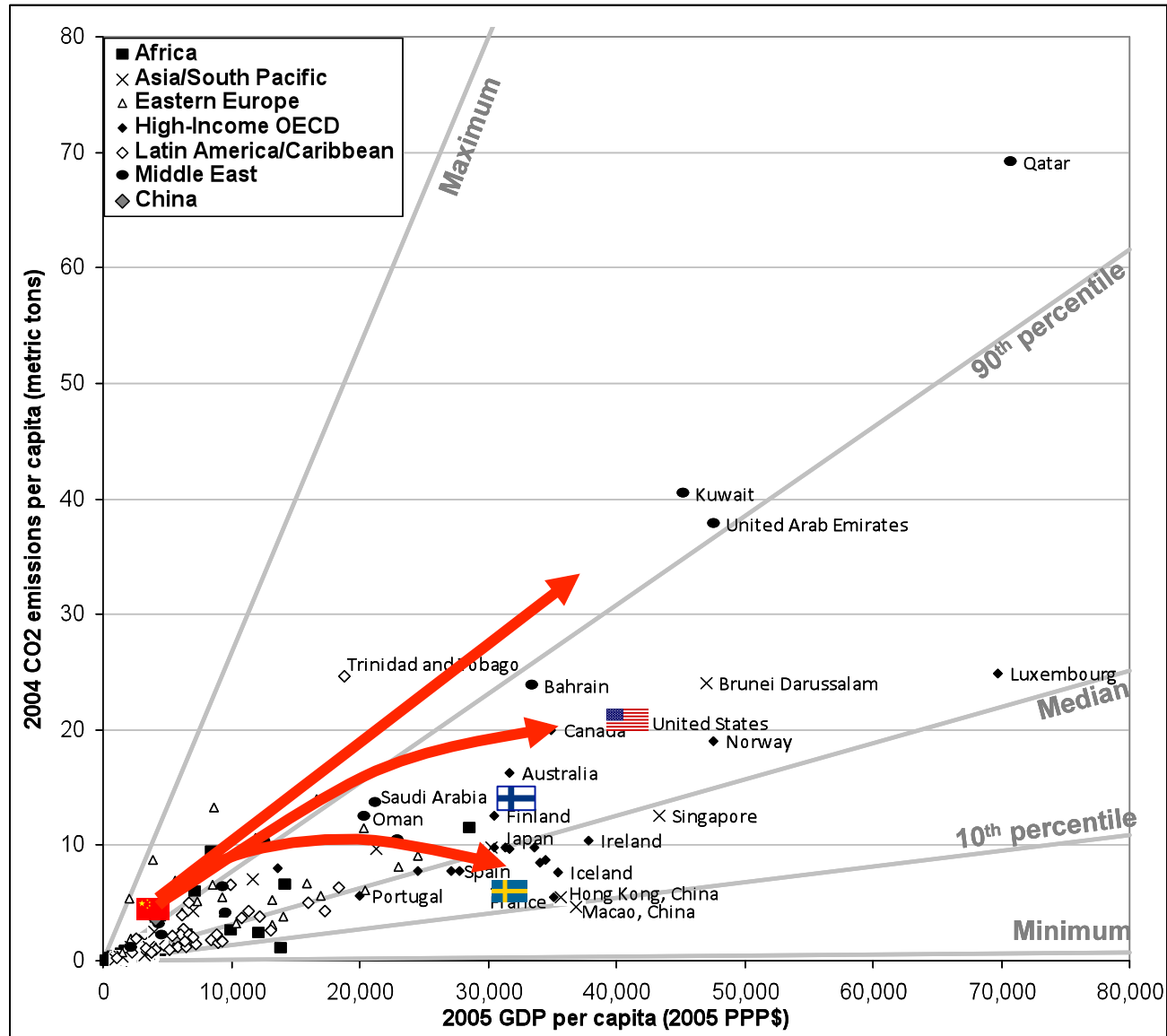

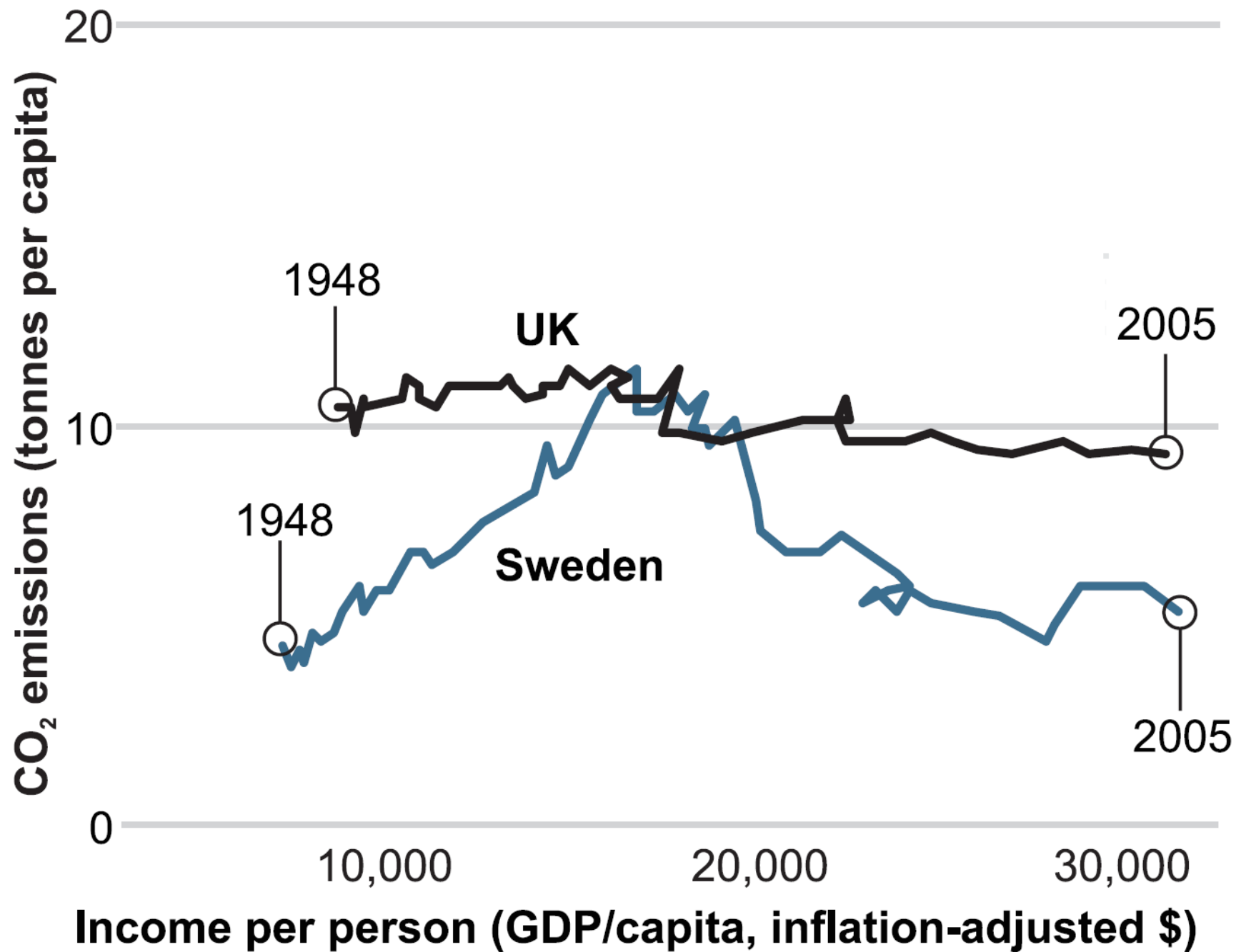

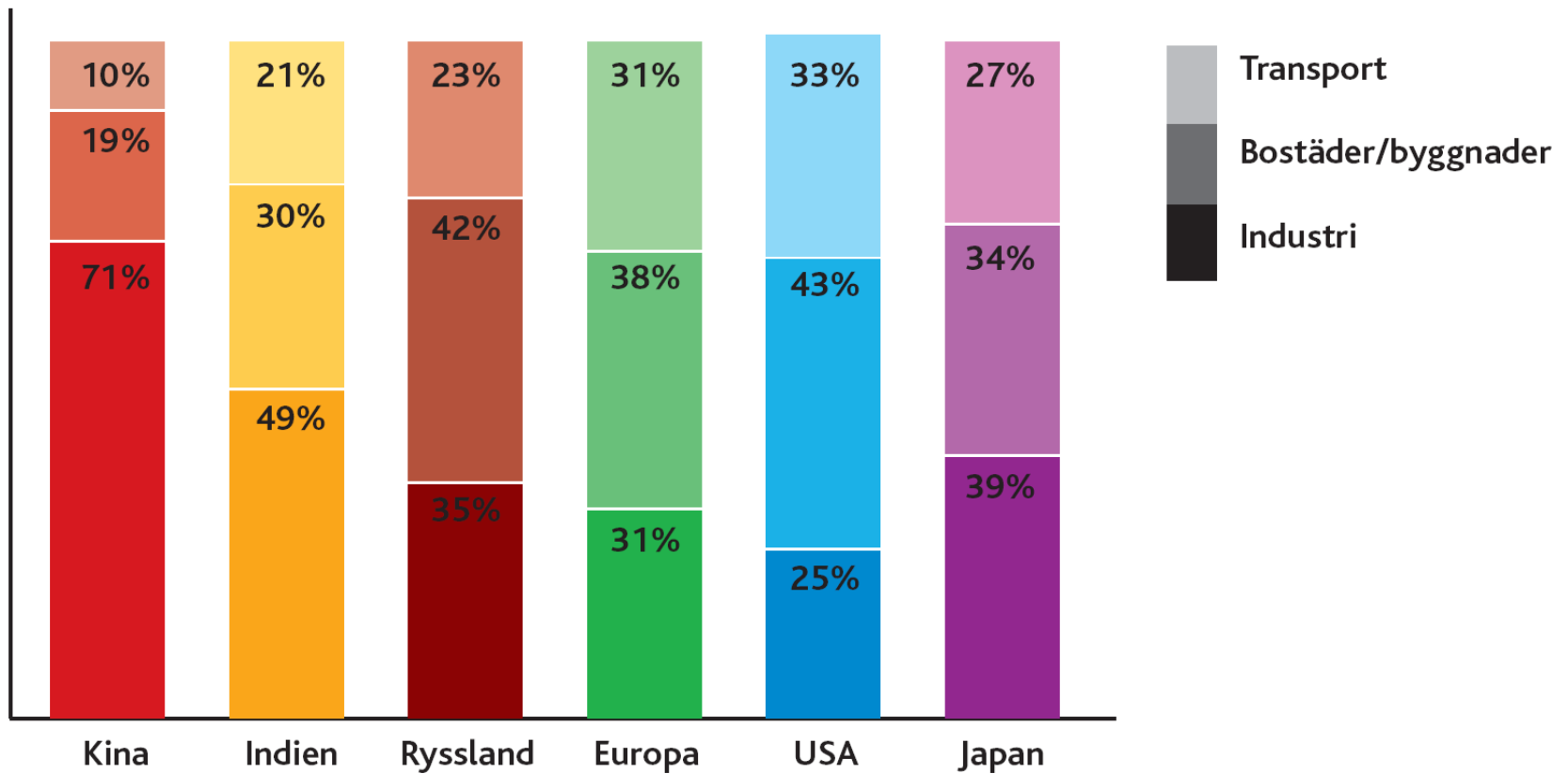


CO2 emission per capita vs. GDP per capita (PPP)

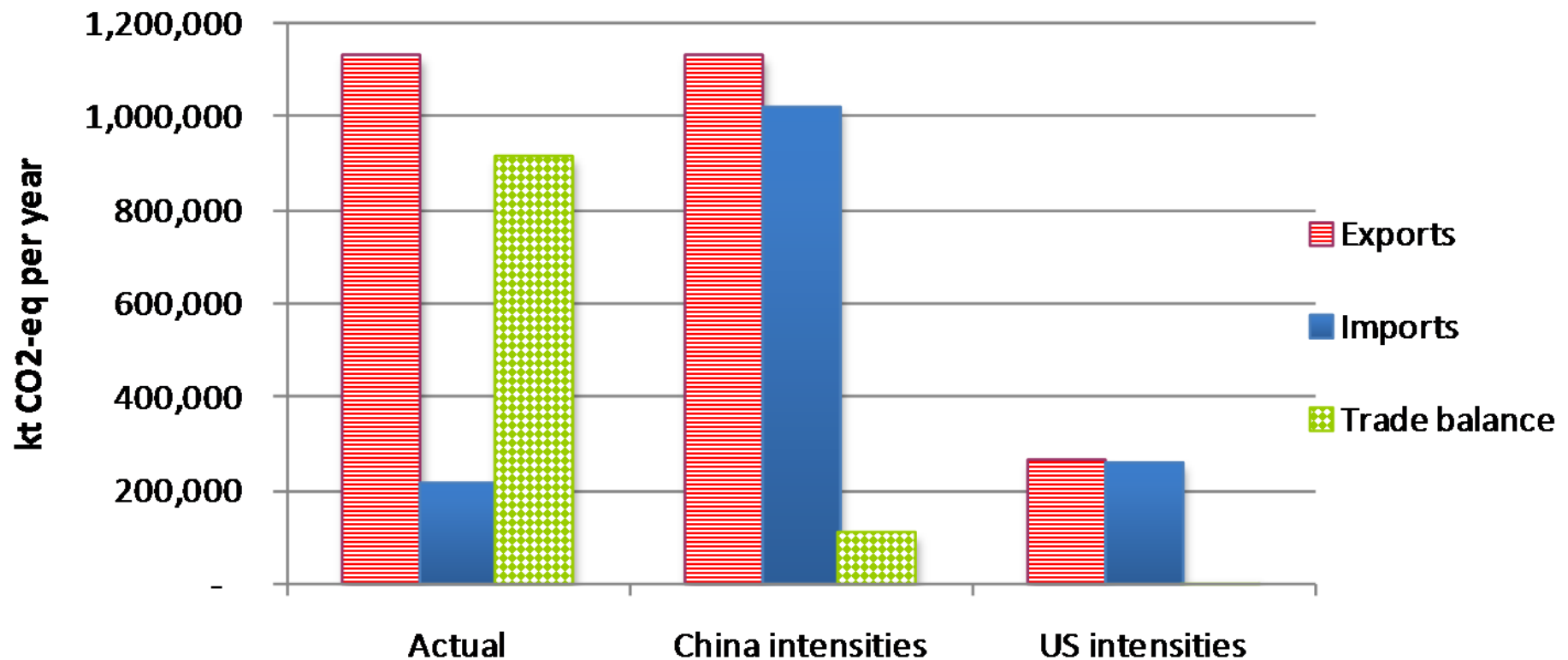




Industry dominates China's energy demand
