

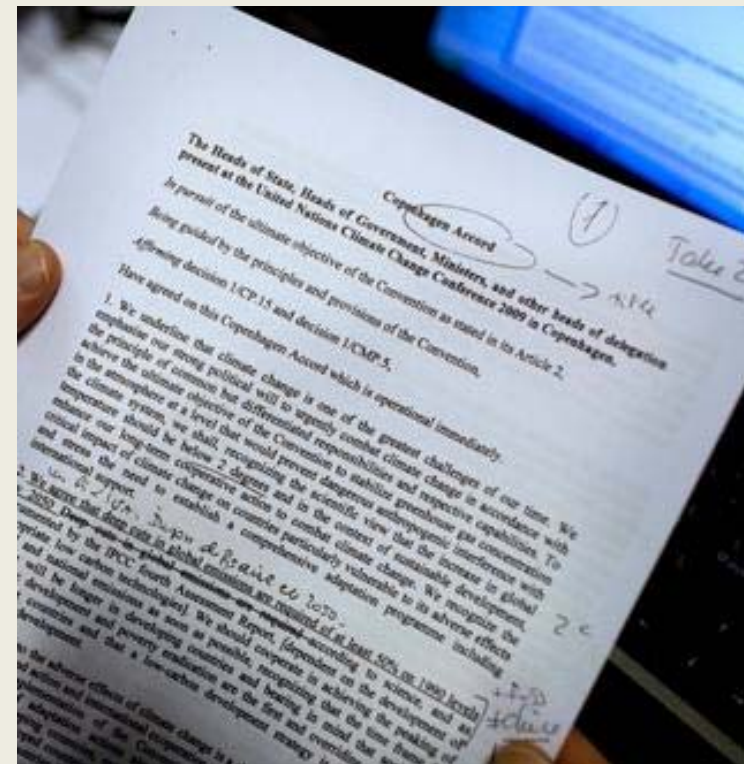
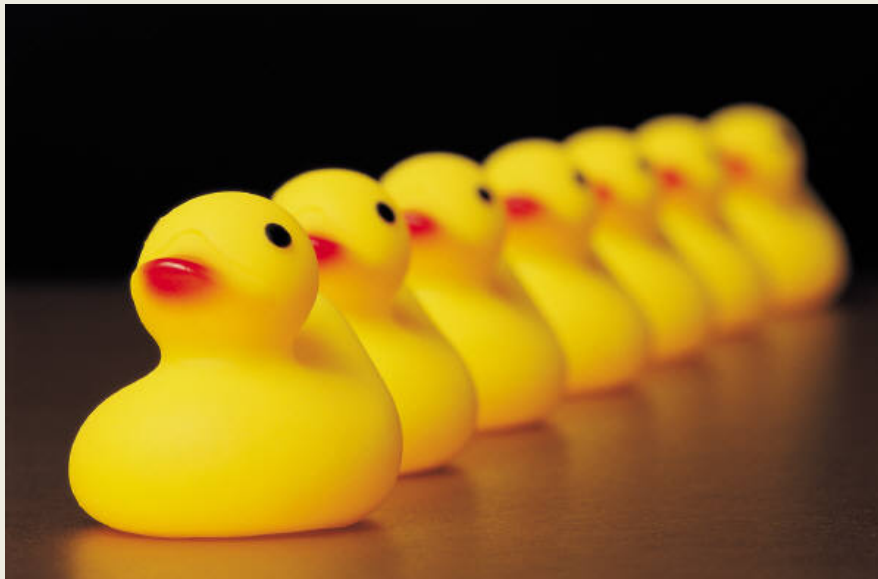

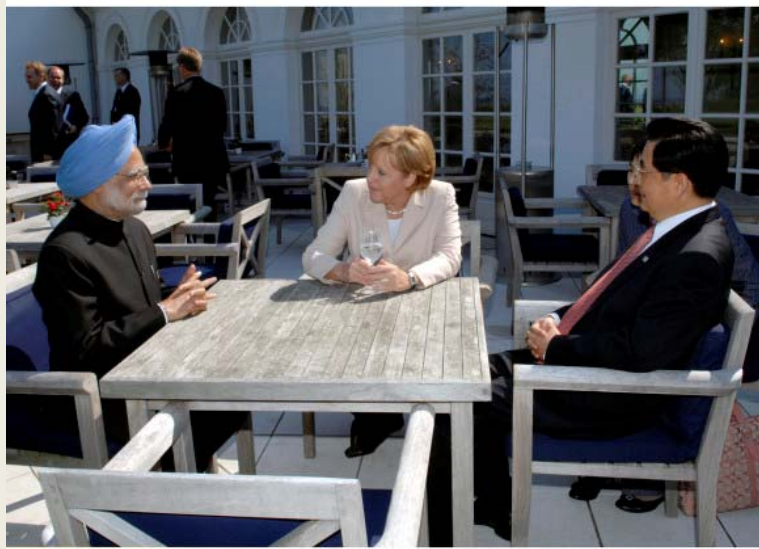
In agreement on:

- Anchored in G77

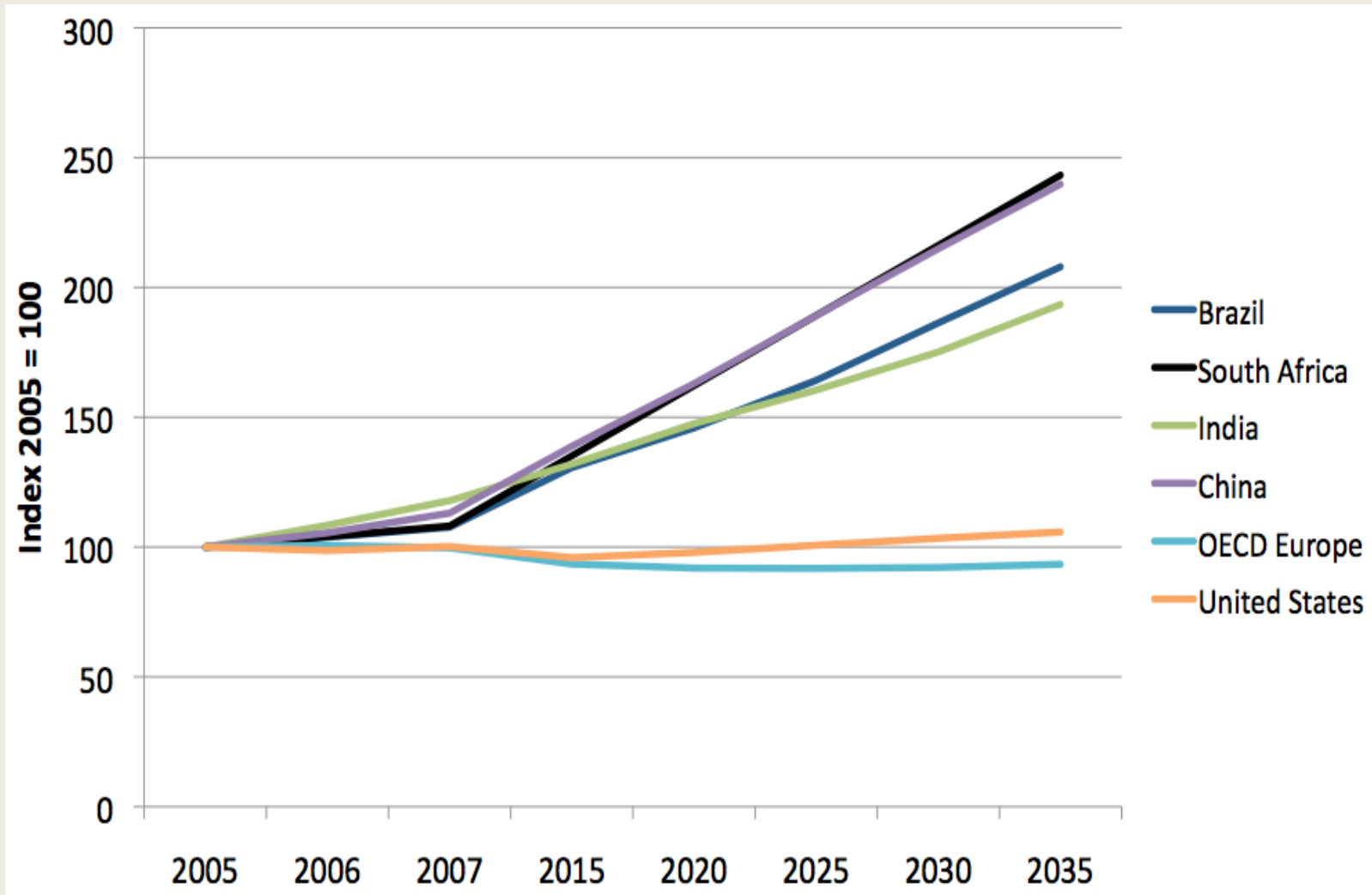
G77 fragmentation

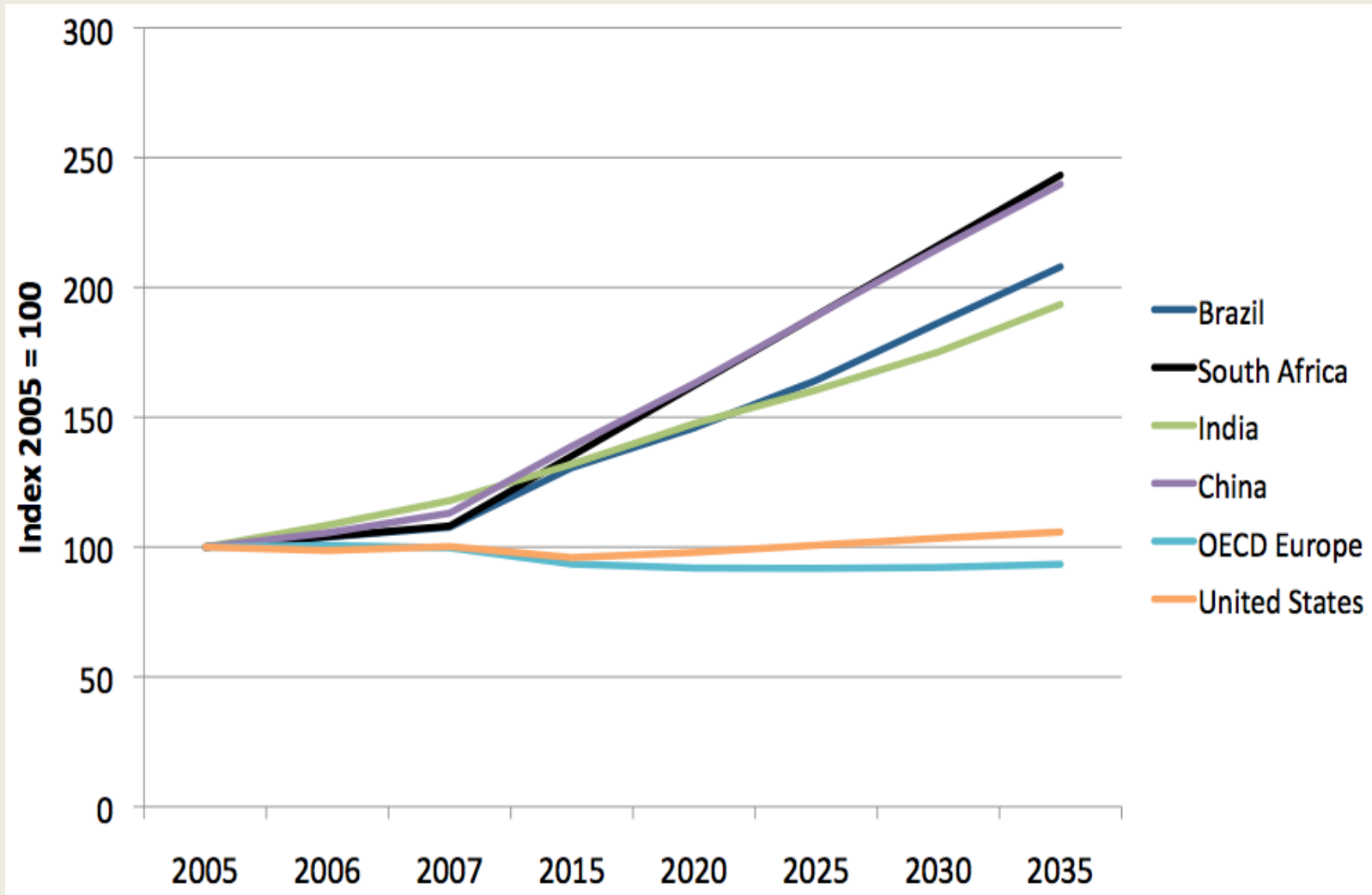
BASIC in 2010
